Industry needs new dentists

Growth in the number of practicing dentists has leveled off compared to overall population growth in the United States. The lack of new dentists has resulted in a dentist-to-patient ratio decline.

- In some states like Delaware and Arkansas, there are no dental schools.
 Without a dental school, these states are dependent on the recruitment of dentists.
- In states like Florida and Colorado, the majority of dentists are located in metropolitan areas, resulting in rural patients being underserved.
- In states like New Hampshire and Oregon, dentists are reaching the age for retirement. More than half of the dentists in both states are over the age of 45.
- In states like North Carolina and North Dakota, the majority of the counties are nationally recognized as Dental Health Professional Shortage Areas.
- States like Rhode Island and South Carolina have below average dentist-to-population ratios.


Dental Select Network



Unique Dentists




National Network Growth

Comparing networks - what you need to know

There is confusion when comparing networks because of how they're reported. There are two primary ways that dental carriers report their network size.

- Unique dentists: This is a count of individual dentists in the network. Each
 dentist is counted one time regardless of the number of clinics where they
 practice.
- Access points: This is a count of all the locations where each individual
 dentist practices. The parameters used for identifying locations varies
 significantly between carriers. This is the most common measurement for
 national networks.
