Medicare Advantage Annual Wellness Visits

Medicare members are eligible for Medicare preventive and annual wellness visits. Visits vary based upon a member's enrollment date in Medicare.

Billing and Documentation FAQs:

1) Can an evaluation-and-management (E/M) service be performed along with an AWV, Annual Physical Exam or IPPE?

Annual Wellness Visits (AWV), Annual Physical Exams and IPPEs may be performed with a separately identifiable evaluation-and-management service. The claim and medical record must support the services. If these conditions are met, report the additional CPT code with modifier -25. If an additional E/M is billed, a member may have cost sharing.

2) Does member cost sharing apply?

Lab and diagnostic procedures ordered during Medicare preventive and AWVs may have a separate member cost-sharing.

3) Does HP allow for separate reimbursement for an annual physical plus AWV or IPPE on the same day?

Yes, as long as both services are provided and documented.
