Influenza Vaccine to Effectively Stop Cardio Thoracic Events and Decompensated Heart Failure (INVESTED) (Solomon/Verdeny)

Influenza infection is known to be associated with increased risk of cardiovascular events, and leads to significant morbidity and mortality each year. Annual influenza vaccination is recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, but the optimal vaccine regimen that portends the most protection in patients with high risk cardiovascular disease is unclear. The INVESTED study is a multi-center, randomized, active- control clinical trial of high dose influenza vaccine compared to standard dose influenza vaccine for three seasons in adult individuals with a history of myocardial infarction or heart failure who are at high risk for cardiovascular events. The results of this trial have the potential to inform health care policy regarding optimal influenza vaccination for individuals with high risk cardiovascular disease, which may in turn reduce morbidity from this annual threat to health stability in patients with cardiovascular conditions.

Blood Pressure Checks and Hypertension Diagnosis and Control (BP-CHECK) (Green)

Almost 1 in 3 Americans have hypertension—sustained high blood pressure (BP). Hypertension is the leading risk factor for cardiovascular disease (CVD), the most common cause of avoidable death and disability in the U.S. Our primary outcome is differences in mean systolic and diastolic BP comparing clinic, home, and kiosk to 24-hour BP and to examine the knowledge, preferences, and beliefs of providers (physicians, nurses, and MAs), managers, and organizational leaders about BP diagnostic tests pre and post study; to identify implementation barriers and facilitators for clinic, home, kiosk, and 24-hour BP monitoring. We hope to develop a better understanding of the effects of treatment options for severe postpartum hemorrhage and subsequent complications.
