ASHP Accredited PGY1 Purpose: [Our] PGY1 pharmacy residency program builds on Doctor of Pharmacy education and outcomes to develop clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification and postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

Resident Experience:

- ❖ 6-8 weeks orientation and pharmacy services training (incl. Anti-Coag, AMS, TPN, PK).
- ❖ Residents complete 10 months of 4 to 5 week core and elective rotations (length of elective rotations is flexible)

OVERVIEW OF OUR RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

Our PGY-1 Pharmacy Practice Residency is a 12-month program offered at Methodist Hospital in St. Louis Park, Minnesota. Residency experiences may be tailored to the resident's interests. Our program is accredited by ASHP.

Additional Program Activities:

- ❖ Presentation of the pharmacy residency project at a regional Residency Conference
- ❖ Attendance at and preparation of a poster for the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting
- ❖ Attendance and participation at P & T Committee meetings, along with 2 to 3 other hospital committees (resident's choice)
- ❖ Medication use evaluation / Drug monographs
- ❖ Off-site visits to at least one other Park Nicollet specialty clinic / program such as the *Heart & Vascular Center, Melrose [Eating Disorder Treatment] Center, International Diabetes Center, and Fraumshuh Cancer Center*
- ❖ Opportunity to teach in courses at the University of Minnesota College of Pharmacy
- ❖ Assist with precepting APPE / IPPE students
- ❖ Opportunity to attend medical / specialty & Family Medicine noon conferences
- ❖ Residency Grand Rounds – formal patient case presentation & journal club activities
- ❖ Assist with recruitment of future residents
- ❖ Community Wellness event / Newsletter
- ❖ ACLS / BLS training and certification
