What is SharedSpace4Learning?

SharedSpace4Learning is a web-based application that enables each member within the HealthPartners student learning environment to take an active role in creating, tracking and evaluating their learning experiences.

Background

HealthPartners provides a rich learning culture for all types of trainees. We continue to experience increased demand for training experiences with the opening of new schools and online programs. Complex and resource-intensive processes have been created within HealthPartners over time to coordinate and track training and learning experiences. They reflect the professionally planned and thoughtfully executed work of many dedicated colleagues throughout our system.

SS4L was developed to:

- Remove existing barriers to building educational connections and experiences
- Simplify the process of setting up availability and proposed rotations for students
- Provide real-time training information on easy to read dashboards and reports

What are its limitations/what will it not do?

SS4L does not make decisions or change the decision-making process for users, who retain local control for how they integrate the platform in their environments.

What was there before SS4L? What process/workflows will it replace?

SS4L was collaboratively developed by stakeholders across the organization and with our community partners. It centrally unifies and supports many different workflows in a simple, consistent, and efficient platform.

What are some practical benefits of using SS4L?

User experience feedback has shown benefits including

- reduced time spent emailing and with phone calls
- the ability to learn about student applicants and for them to learn about preceptors
- enhanced tracking of the onboarding of learners

What can the SharedSpace4Learning application do?

SS4L is a web-based application that simplifies how users create, track and evaluate their learning experiences

- learners can explore and request learning opportunities
- preceptors can express interest and availability to train and evaluate them
- training site administrators can capture and coordinate training at their sites
- partner schools/programs can request, track, and inventory their students' learning experiences
- administrators system-wide can track distribution and completion of required on-boarding documents
