Personal attacks, racism, spamming, thread hijacking, trolling and repetitive or excessive posting will not be tolerated. Hateful or discriminatory comments regarding personal characteristics or beliefs, such as race, ethnicity, religion, gender, gender identity, disability, sexual orientation, veteran status or political beliefs also will not be tolerated.

We also reserve the right to remove posts that advertise commercial products, competing brands, organizations that are not related to us or our mission and services, and any post that we believe to be inaccurate, fraudulent, deceptive or otherwise objectionable or off-topic.

And of course, we prohibit posts that violate the law, including posts that violate intellectual property rights or privacy rights, and posts that violate Facebook's terms of service.
