

Heart disease - Primary Care

Vascular disease is any condition that affects the heart or blood vessels (veins and arteries that transport blood through the body). Vascular disease can lead to hardening or clogging of the arteries, which can limit the heart's ability to supply oxygen and nutrients to your body. High-quality care for vascular disease includes measuring these treatment goals: •If your blood pressure is appropriate less than 140/90 mmHg) •That you are not using tobacco •That you take an aspirin daily if appropriate
