ONE Campaign - Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT IS THE ONE CAMPAIGN EMPLOYEE GIVING CAMPAIGN?

ONE Campaign is an annual employee giving campaign at HealthPartners. The campaign encourages colleagues to give donations to the areas of patient care, research and education so that we can further improve health and well-being in partnership with our members, patients and community.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO DONATE TO THE ONE CAMPAIGN?

When you donate to the ONE Campaign, it sends a meaningful endorsement that you believe strongly in the work that our organization does to improve health and well-being for those we serve.

WHO IS ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ONE CAMPAIGN?

Colleagues at HealthPartners, HealthPartners Clinics, Regions Hospital, Stillwater Medical Group, Lakeview Hospital, Hudson Hospital and Clinic, Westfields Hospital, Amery Hospital and Clinics and Park Nicollet are able to donate to the ONE Campaign. This also includes Capitol View Transitional Care Center, Integrated Home Care, North Suburban, Physicians Neck and Back, TRIA, and RiverWay Clinics.

IS DONATING TO THE ONE CAMPAIGN MANDATORY?

Donating to the ONE Campaign is entirely voluntary. Although we strongly encourage colleagues to donate, giving is not mandatory.

WHAT CAN I DONATE TO?

The ONE Campaign donations can be made to three areas: patient and family experience, research and education, and community benefit. For the specific options available to you, please review your employer group's specific pledge form.

CAN I DONATE TO MORE THAN ONE AREA?

Yes, many colleagues choose to donate to more than one area. On the ONE campaign pledge form, you have the option to designate what amount of your total donation you would like to give to each area.



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HOW DO I MAKE A DONATION TO THE ONE CAMPAIGN?

There are multiple ways for you to donate. You can donate online through payroll deduction or credit card. You can fill out a paper donation form to make donations or via payroll deduction, cash, check or credit card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or Visa).

WHAT IS THE SUSTAINING DONOR PROGRAM?

The ONE campaign sustaining donor program automatically renews a colleague's donation each year. That means your donations through payroll deduction will continue until you ask for the deducting to be cancelled. Annually, you will receive an email from the ONE campaign that provides you with the opportunity to increase, decrease, stop, or reallocate your gift.

WHEN CAN I MAKE A DONATION?

The 2018 ONE campaign begins on Sunday, April 1, 2018 and runs through Monday, April 30, 2018. We strongly encourage you to donate during this time. Donations that are given by Monday, April 30, 2018 will be matched by HealthPartners.

IS MY DONATION TO THE ONE CAMPAIGN TAX DEDUCTIBLE?

Yes, your full donation to the ONE Campaign is tax deductible.

WHAT IF I CAN'T AFFORD TO DONATE TO THE ONE CAMPAIGN?

The ONE campaign is entirely voluntary. Every donation, no matter the size, counts and all contributions remain confidential.



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WHO OVERSEES THE ONE CAMPAIGN?

The ONE campaign is jointly coordinated by the Amery Hospital and Clinics Foundation, Hudson Hospital Foundation, Lakeview Foundation, Park Nicollet Foundation, Regions Hospital Foundation, and Westfields Hospital Foundation. Each raises philanthropic dollars for a multitude of programs and are registered 501(c)(3) organizations within the state of Minnesota or Wisconsin.
