### What is the One Campaign employee giving campaign?

The One Campaign is an annual employee giving campaign at HealthPartners. The campaign encourages colleagues to give donations to the areas of patient and family experience, research and education and community benefit so that we can further improve health and well-being in partnership with our members, patients and community.

### Why is it important to donate to the One Campaign?

When you donate to the One Campaign, it sends a meaningful message that you believe in the work that our organization does to improve health and wellbeing for those we serve.

### Who is able to participate in the One Campaign?

Colleagues at HealthPartners, Amery Hospital & Clinic, HealthPartners Clinics, Hudson Hospital, Hutchinson Health, Lakeview Hospital and Clinic, Park Nicollet, Regions Hospital, Stillwater Medical Group and Westfields Hospital & Clinic and are able to donate to the One Campaign. This also includes Capitol View Transitional Care Center, North Suburban, Physicians Neck and Back, TRIA, and RiverWay Clinics.

### Is donating to the One Campaign required?

Donating to the One Campaign is voluntary. Although we encourage colleagues to donate if they are able to do so.

### What can I donate to through the One Campaign?

### Can I donate to more than one area?

Yes, many colleagues choose to donate to more than one area. On the One Campaign pledge form, you have the option to designate what amount of your total donation you would like to give to each area.

### How do I make a donation to the One Campaign?

There are multiple ways for you to donate. You can [donate online](#) through payroll deduction or credit card. You can also fill out a paper donation form to make donations via payroll deduction, cash, check or credit card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or Visa).

### What is the sustaining donor program?

The One Campaign sustaining donor program automatically renews a colleague's donation each year. That means your donations will continue through payroll deduction until you ask for the deductions to be cancelled. Annually, you will receive an email that provides you with the opportunity to increase, decrease, stop or reallocate your gift.

### When can I make a donation?

The 2020 One Campaign begins on Wednesday, April 1, 2020 and runs through Thursday, April 30, 2020. We strongly encourage you to donate during this time. Donations that are given by Thursday, April 30, 2020 are eligible for a partial match from HealthPartners.

### Is my donation to the One Campaign tax deductible?

Yes, your full donation to the One Campaign is tax deductible.

### What if I can't afford to donate to the One Campaign?

The One Campaign is entirely voluntary. Every donation, no matter the size, makes a difference in the lives our of patients and members. All contributions to the One Campaign remain confidential.
