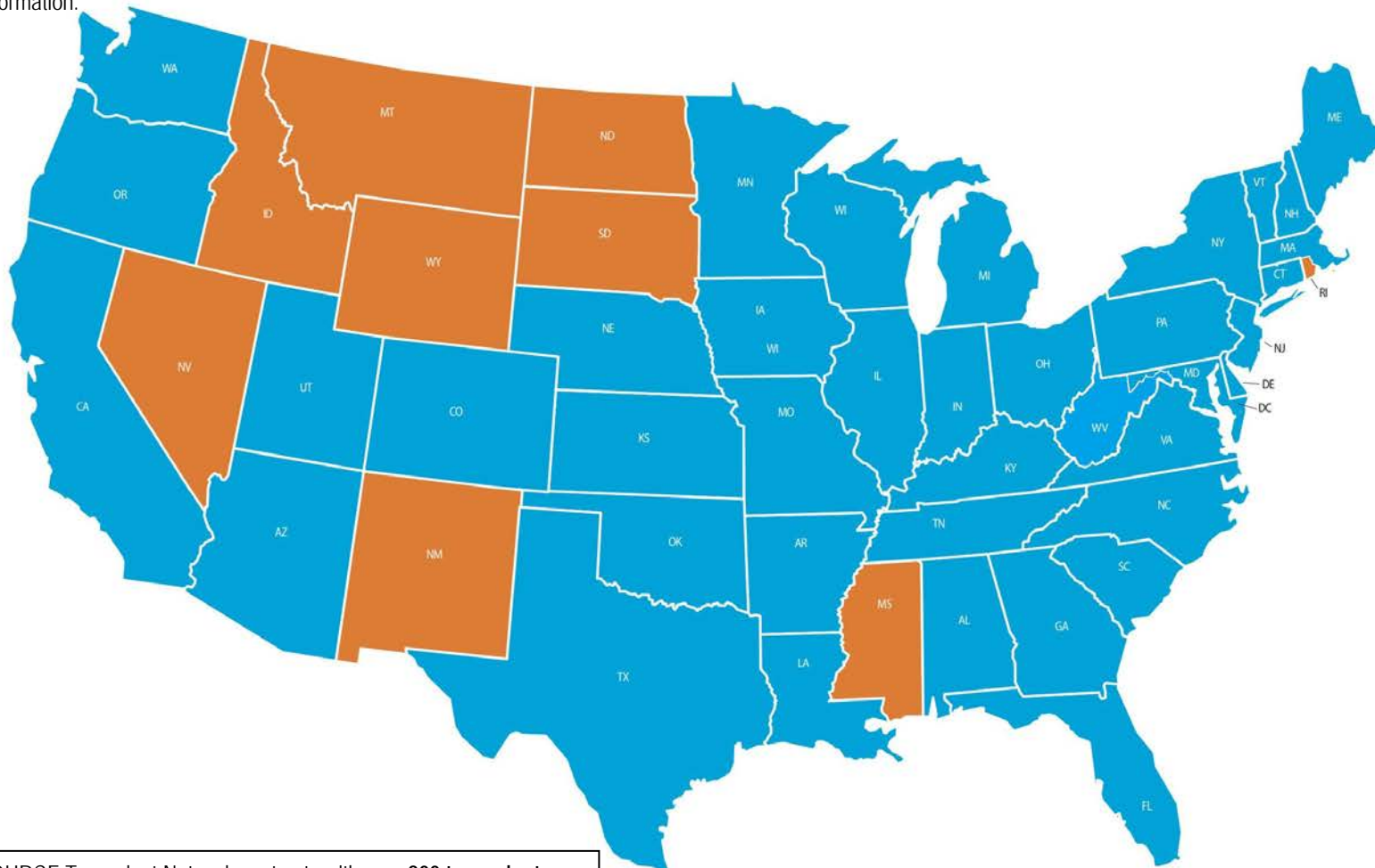


# SUPPLEMENTAL PROGRAMS
