Specialty medicines are usually prescribed by doctors who treat chronic and complex disease. These medications usually require a higher degree of management, have a high price and are not generally stocked at retail pharmacies. Professionallyadministered drugs are typically billed on the medical benefit. Self-administered drugs are generally billed on the pharmacy benefit. Many specialty drugs require approval prior touse.
