



Drug Formulary Update, July 2020 Commercial Programs

Updates to the HealthPartners Commercial Formularies (PreferredRx and GenericsAdvantageRx) are listed below.

Please see www.healthpartners.com/formularies for details.

All changes are effective July 1 2020.

Members currently receiving medications with negative changes are given additional time (through August 31), to work with their provider to update their medication or to submit a prior authorization request. All affected members receive additional communications.

HealthPartners is also updating coverage for diabetic supplies. Certain diabetic supplies must be purchased from a pharmacy, starting October 1 2020.

- Dexcom and FreeStyle Libre continuous glucose monitoring systems must be purchased from a pharmacy. Prior authorization is required.
- Guardian continuous glucose monitoring system can be purchased at either setting (from a pharmacy or from a DME vendor). Prior authorization is required at both settings. The Guardian is reserved for patients using the Medtronic MiniMed insulin pump, due to the integrated functionality. Current members have been “grandfathered” through December 31 2020.
- Glucose test strips and glucose meters must be purchased from a pharmacy.
